

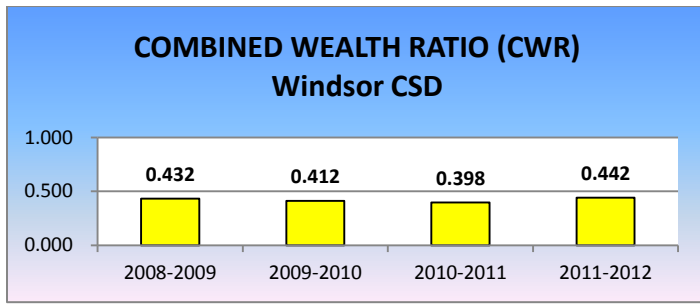
COMBINED WEALTH RATIO (CWR)

The **Combined Wealth Ratio (CWR)** is used in State Aid Formulas and has a direct impact on State funding. **CWR** is used to compare district wealth to the State average wealth. Two components are used in the calculation of **CWR**, a district's property wealth and the personal income wealth of its residents.

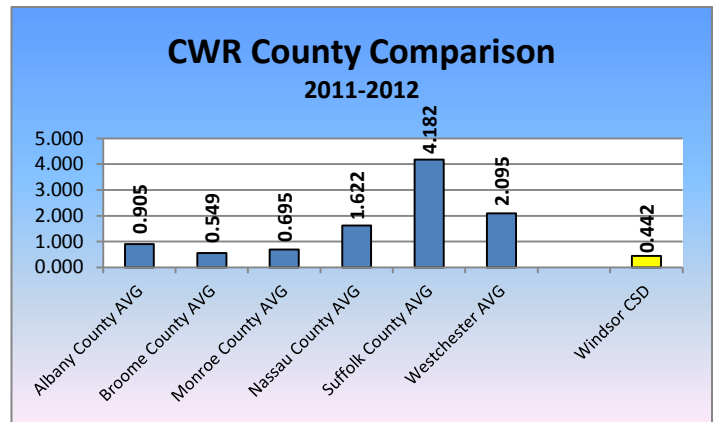
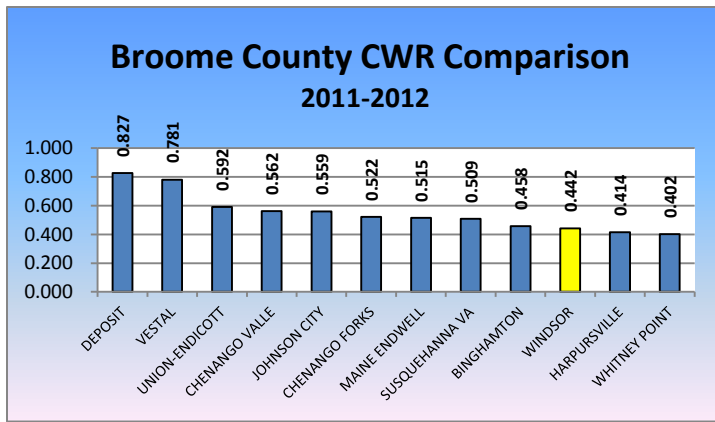
1.00 = Average Wealth <1.00 = Wealth **BELOW** State Average >1.00 Wealth **ABOVE** State Average

QUESTION: What is Windsor Central School District's Combined Wealth Ratio?

ANSWER: 0.442



1.0 = Average Wealth
 < 1.00 = Wealth **BELOW** State Average
 > 1.00 = Wealth **ABOVE** State



THE BOTTOM LINE

The Windsor Central School District Wealth is considerably **BELOW THE STATE AVERAGE**. In fact our CWR is among the lowest locally as well (see above chart).

IMPLICATION

Our District has relatively lower ability to pay for education at the local level.
