RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE WINDSOR CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT REGARDING A DETERMINATION ON THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT ON A PROPOSED PROJECT.

At the regular meeting of the Board of Education for the Windsor Central School District, Broome County, New York, held at 1191 NY Route 79, Windsor, New York, in said School District on the 10th day of October, 2016 at 6:00 P.M. WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Windsor Central School District ("Board") is proposing to undertake a project consisting of limited interior flooring repair/replacement at the High School ("the Project"); and WHEREAS, the Board wishes to fully comply with its

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to fully comply with its obligations under the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) and the regulations thereunder with respect to the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, the Board has carefully considered the nature and scope of the proposed action; and

NOW THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Windsor Central School District, Broome County, New York, as follows:

- Section 1. The proposed action involves limited interior flooring repair/replacement at the High School.
- Section 2. The Board of Education hereby declares itself lead agency pursuant to SEQRA.
- Section 3. The review will be not be a coordinated review.
- Section 4. The proposed project represents maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing facility or structure within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(1); and/or represents a routine activity of an educational institution within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(8).
- Section 5. The proposed action will in no case have a significant adverse impact on the environment based on the criteria contained in 6 NYCRR § 617.7(c), and is not otherwise a Type I action as defined by 6 NYCRR § 617.4
- Section 6. The proposed action is a Type II action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5 and is therefore not subject to review under SEQRA and the regulations thereunder.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board finds and concludes that the proposed action is a Type II action within the meaning of 6 NYCRR 617.5 and therefore is not subject to review under SEQRA and the regulations thereunder.
