Seniors receive additional information regarding senior privileges with this mailing. These include permission forms for late arrival, early release, and off campus lunch. All forms must be returned to the main office prior to using the senior privileges. Please contact the office asap if these are not received.

As a reminder to all students who drive to school, you are required to register your car with the main office. Student parking will be in the lower parking lot (near the baseball field.) The "circle" is reserved for faculty.
