COURSE OFFERINGS

Courses are open to adult residents and non-residents. (Adults are defined as someone 18 years of age or older and no longer attending high school.) The exception is the Defensive Driving Course, which also is offered to licensed high school students.

If school is not in session, cancelled for the day or closed during the day; there will be no adult classes that evening.

Enrollees in adult education who are over 62 years of age will be admitted to classes free of charge if they are a resident of the district. Since there is a limited amount of money set aside for this use, it will be distributed on a first come first served basis. Forms for this purpose will be provided to individuals in the first class. **There are no waivers for the classes that charge certification fees i.e. Defensive Driving.*

BASKETBALL (Competitive)

These courses are centered on playing basketball for fun and fitness. Enrollees are assumed to be familiar with the rules of the game and basic play. No instruction will be provided. *Thursday basketball begins 1/21/10.
