*Please note that Universal Pre-K programs will be operated at Weeks, Bell and Palmer Schools. To be eligible for the Universal Pre-kindergarten Program a student must be 4 years old and a resident of the district (must be 4 on or before December 1st). All students must also meet New York State immunization requirements and be "potty trained".*

On April 23, 2010 a lottery will be held to determine Universal Pre-K enrollment. Applicants will be informed of their lottery status by Wednesday April 28, 2010. Lottery numbers do not determine the order of placement of UPK students into building programs. A lottery number determines eligibility for a position in the UPK program. Parents will be notified of student program placement by May 19<sup>th</sup>.
