Student Selection: By district-wide lottery

Selection Procedure: Seventy-two (72) spaces are available for Universal Pre-Kindergarten students (UPK) as determined by lottery on April 23rd. Parents will be notified April 28th of lottery results. All Universal Pre-Kindergarten positions will be filled through one lottery.

Student Transportation:

Bell and Palmer all day programs – normal elementary runs
 Weeks AM – in on the normal elementary run and out on a midday run
 Weeks PM – in on a midday run and out on the normal elementary run

Palmer to Weeks for a half day program

<u>AM</u>	The district will provide the transportation
<u>PM</u>	The district will provide the transportation

Weeks to Palmer for a full day program – the district will provide the transportation

Bell to Weeks for a half day program

<u>AM</u>	The district will provide the transportation
<u>PM</u>	The district will provide the transportation

Weeks to Bell for a full day program – parent(s) will need to provide the transportation

Any other transportation arrangements are the responsibility of the parent/guardian (Ex: Palmer to Bell).

Staffing: The Windsor Central School District will staff the classroom with one SED certified teacher and one teacher aide and support staff as appropriate.

Medical: Day-to-day emergency medical support and screening tests normally completed for K-5 students will be provided by the WCSD.

At the present time all program planning is tentative – contingent upon adequate funding from the State Education Department. (Per pupil and number of pupils.) All students must meet NYS immunization requirements and be "potty trained". To be eligible for the Universal Pre-Kindergarten program a student must be 4 years old and a resident of the district (must be 4 on or before December 1st).
