🕠 Read/Think/Select:

Use reading strategies:

- Read a "chunk" at a time, such as a whole paragraph or page.
- Look for visual clues such as bolded words and subsections.
- Use a Table of Contents, index, or menu to jump to subtopic information.

THINK about what you read and locate facts that match your subtopics

SELECT facts for note-taking and skip what is not important.



O Note-taking:

Use your index cards in the method you practiced



Sort and Number Notes:

- READ all notes within a subtopic section
- THINK about moving notes around so they make more sense when you write.
- NUMBER the notes in the new order and follow the numbers for easy writing.
