Read/Think/Select:

Use reading strategies:

- *Read a "chunk" at a time, such as a whole paragraph or page.*
- *Look for visual clues such as bolded words and subsections.*
- *Use a Table of Contents, index, or menu to jump to subtopic information.*

THINK about what you read and locate facts that match your subtopics

SELECT facts for note-taking and skip what is not important.



Note-taking:

Use your index cards in the method you practiced



Sort and Number Notes:

- *READ all notes within a subtopic section*
- *THINK about moving notes around so they make more sense when you write.*
- *NUMBER the notes in the new order and follow the numbers for easy writing.*



Evaluate:

Is there a part of this process that helped you do research more easily?

What did you learn about your topic?
